Jimi Flowers Classic Swim Meet January 15-16,

In memory of our friend and former colleague, Jimi Flowers, the USOC will be hosting The Jimi Flowers Classic Swim Meet on January 16-17, 2016. This meet will be an exciting world class competition held at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs featuring several of the USA's top Paralympic swimmers.

Jimi Flowers began his career with the USOC in 1989 working as USA Swimming's national team coordinator. He later served as the aquatics center manager before taking on the role of national team manager and resident team coach for the U.S. Paralympics swimming program in 2007. An avid climber and lover of the outdoors, Flowers lost his life after a tragic climbing accident at Capitol Peak near Aspen, Colorado on July 10, 2009. For those who never had a chance to meet Jimi, he was an extraordinary husband, father, USOC staff member and swim coach. I encourage you to take a moment and watch this video about Jimi.
