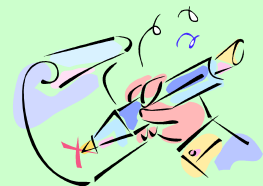

Business Continuity

Ken Hughlett, BS, NRP – Ken is currently a Senior Emergency Management Specialist for the Colorado Springs Utilities' Emergency Management and Business Continuity. During recent disasters, Ken has functioned as the Logistics' Section Chief and Food Unit Supervisor for the Joplin Tornado and as an EOC Director during the Waldo Canyon Fire, Black Forest Fire, numerous flooding events, and other large planned events. Ken is also an EMS Instructor in Colorado with 13 years' experience teaching EMTs and Paramedics. He has a B.S. in Occupational Safety and Health from Columbia Southern University, Nationally Registered Paramedic, and State Certified Paramedic. Ken has over 27 years' experience in both emergency response and occupational safety, and has presented at many conferences on topics ranging from disaster response, community CPR and AEDs program, and turkey ergonomics.

Ken will provide insight on the Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) / Business Continuity concepts used to ensure that your business remains functional during and after disasters. Open Board Positions...

Chapter Vice President / President Elect

Preside in the absence of the president. The vice president should work closely with the president and be prepared to step in should the president be unable to complete his or her term of office. In an ideal succession planning process, you should be capable of being elected president when the current president's term expires and conducting a seamless transition. It is imperative that he/she studies the chapter's bylaws and keeps up-to-date on all chapter activities.

Secretary

Take comprehensive notes at regular and special meetings of the Board of Directors, including the annual Strategic Planning meeting. Distribute meeting minutes to all members of the Board of Directors and meeting attendees soon after the meeting covered by the minutes. Understand the By-laws of the Pikes Peak Chapter and assist and advise the Pikes Peak Chapter Board Members relating to any issues relating to the by-lays.

Sponsorship Chairperson

Plan, direct, organize and manage the Chapter Sponsorship Activities within the guidelines, policies and through the direction of the Pikes Peak Chapter of IFMA Board. Coordinates and maintains the functionality of the Monthly Luncheon Sponsorship program for the Pikes Peak Chapter of IFMA. Organize the Sponsorship Committee. Recruit members to activity be involved within the goals and objectives of the Sponsorship Committee. Actively recruits potential sponsors for monthly lunch sponsorship.
